The course is constantly evolving, adding in new skills, new equipment, it just gets better and better. Anyone who has previously attended the course is welcome back to enhance and develop new skills and to have fun.

Cost for the course for everyone is £60 payable by BACS which includes the Monday sessions, Saturday sessions, site fees, and food for all events and camps. Final details of payment and locations for the sessions are given along with confirmation of your registration. Spaces are limited to 24 newcomers this year, no restriction on those continuing or returning however all wishing to attend need to register. Specifically designed for Scouts, Explorers and Leaders in the District and also parents may join in too as long as they are DBS/CRB cleared by their Group.

Participate in the practical side of woodcraft and backwoods skills, camping without a tent.

Fun and skills for all, no previous bushcraft experience required.

Scouts must have previously camped outdoors with their Scout Troop and be over 111/2 years on 1st Jan Practice cooking for yourselves outdoors and trying different wild foods and drinks.

Sleep under a tarp (first year) or in a hammock or build your own shelter.

Making gadgets and tools from natural materials.

Using a Knife, Axe and Saw safely in the Bushcraft way.

All you need to know about fires and starting them without a match.



All new members start as Year 1 and attend Level 1 Modules only which covers the most essential skills, plus the two Saturdays and two camps. Years 2 and 3+ are for all those who have attended Year 1 previously.

New members start at **Year 1** and only do Level 1 Modules 1, 2 and 3 plus two Saturday sessions and both camps. Mondays 8th Jan (Module 1), 22nd Jan (Module 2), 5th Feb (Module 3), all sessions run from 7.30 till 9.30 p.m. Saturdays Practical 9th and 23rd March, from 10 a.m. till 4 p.m.

Camps - Week ends of 18th/19th May, 7th/8th Sept, from Sat 10.00 a.m. till Sun 11.00 a.m.
