#### **Minutes**

# **Squirrels and Beavers Nature Day**

- Event Details
  - Date: 28<sup>th</sup> September 2025

- Venue: Phasels Wood Activity Centre
- Key Organiser: Rob Rivers
- Event Format: Two-hour session with four bases across different continents, followed by campfire songs for all.

#### • Budget:

- o Expected Attendees: To be confirmed; estimated 50-100 participants.
- Ticket Pricing: £6 for parents, £5 to the District to directly cover the event costs, £1 to cover group administrative costs.
- Venue Charge: £2 per head. The £100 deposit has been paid, and the balance will be settled when the final numbers are confirmed.
- o A small profit is expected, particularly as this event has no badge costs. This will be used to subsidise future events that are expected to have higher resource costs.

#### Bases

- Discussed various base ideas, including meeting community members (e.g. emergency service personnel), nature walk, crafting, etc. As this is not a badge event, activities did not need to be selected to meet specific criteria. Leaders wanted to run different bases from the previous nature event.
